LOGISTICAL INFORMATION

Location

The class will be held in the conference room of the Institute of East Asian Studies (IEAS) at the University of California, Berkeley, Sixth Floor, 2223 Fulton Street, Berkeley, CA 94720-2318. **Telephone (510) 642-2809**; Fax (510) 643-7062. The institute is located at the southwest corner of campus at the intersection of Kittredge and Fulton Streets. Please see enclosed map or the campus web site at <http://www.berkeley.edu/map/>

To avoid a major football game on November 18th, we will hold that class at the Bay Area Global Education Program at the World Affairs Council located near Union Square in San Francisco at 312 Sutter Street, Suite 200.

Directions to IEAS

If traveling by **BART**, exit the Richmond-Fremont line at the Berkeley station (*not* North Berkeley). When you leave the BART station, walk south down Shattuck Avenue to Kittredge Street (one or two blocks depending on which station exit you leave from) and turn left. Walk one block to Fulton Street and you will be facing the 2223 Fulton Street Building.

To reach the site by car *from Interstate 80*, exit at the University Avenue off-ramp in Berkeley. Take University Avenue east to Oxford Street and turn right. Oxford becomes Fulton Street in a couple of blocks. We are located in the six-story beige building on the east (left) side of the street.

To reach us from *Highways 24/13*, exit 13 at Tunnel Road in Berkeley. Continue on Tunnel Road as it becomes Ashby. Turn right at Telegraph and drive approximately one mile north to Bancroft Way and turn left. The 2223 Fulton Street Building is at the northeast corner of the Bancroft and Fulton intersection (right side).

Parking

Parking is usually available on Saturday in a university lot near the class site (the Bancroft/Fulton campus lot) for \$5.00 all day. The ticket dispensing machine in the parking lot accepts coins, \$1 and \$5 bills.

To park in the university lot if coming *from I-80*: continue south on Fulton, cross Bancroft, and at the next intersection turn left onto Durant Avenue. Stay in the left lane, turn left into the second driveway -- this leads into the Bancroft/Fulton parking lot. If coming *from Highways 24/13*: while on Bancroft pass Ellsworth and turn left into the Bancroft/Fulton parking lot.

There are various public parking lots and facilities near campus and in downtown Berkeley. This list includes municipal and privately owned parking lots and garages open to the public. Please consult signs for hours and fees prior to entering the facilities. The public lot across the street from 2223 Fulton is very expensive.

Other lots:

- Berkeley Way near Shattuck
- Center Street near Shattuck (4-5 hours = \$10.50; 6+ = \$12.00)
- Allston Way near Shattuck (6+ hours=\$12.00)
- Allston Way near Oxford Street
- Kittredge Street near Milvia (4+ hours =\$12.00)

Meals

We will serve coffee and pastries at 8:30 AM and light refreshments during the morning and afternoon breaks.

On October 21st we will host a buffet lunch on the premises to give all the participants a chance to meet each other. On subsequent Saturdays we will host a lunch for participants staying for the afternoon sessions. Please let me know in advance if you are not a credit or stipend student but plan on attending in the afternoon so I can be sure to have enough food.

Credit

Because the last class session will be held during the UCB spring semester, credit students will sign up for “concurrent enrollment” with U. C. Extension for their spring semester. The course is called IAS 310 and is offered for 2 graduate semester credits. We will provide application forms at our November 18th meeting. You must attend morning and afternoon sessions of all five Saturdays (30 hours) to receive credit.
